

Hand Raising Expected Behaviors

1. Respect the teacher and other kids by raising your hand to ask a question, answer a question, or ask to do something.

2. Raise hand high and straight in the air

3. Keep your arm still in the air (no waving or dancing)

4. Keep mouth quiet while raising your hand. (no gasping, yelling, or calling teacher's name)

5. Wait until you are called on to answer the question, ask a question or ask to do something.

6. IF you are called on by your teacher, then answer the question, ask a question, or ask to do something. If you are NOT called on, tell yourself "it's ok, maybe next time" or make a note on your question list.
